The Selwyn Central Community Board held their second community café evening on 22 July, regarding the beautification project of the Rolleston Railway station.

Further answers were sought from the community members in attendance and a draft garden plan was presented based on the comments from the first meeting. The project continues to receive positive feedback.

"It is great to see that the majority of people in attendance live locally and want to see this project through," says Selwyn Central Community Board Chairperson Diane Chesmar.

"It's also exciting to see a variety of different age groups attending these meetings who are keen to be involved too."

"One of the main comments we have received back is that history is important to the community and we want to include that as part of the beautification project through static image boards outlining the area's history and connections to the railway for the Selwyn District", says Mrs Chesmar.

Board members continue to be actively involved across the District in various projects. Mr Bruce Russell (deputy chair) will continue to focus on the 150th West Melton celebrations and return to the project at a later date.
