## Request for Temporary Road Closure – Pig Saddle Road, Waianiwaniwa Road, Malvern Hills Road and Bulls Road

Submissions are invited on a proposal to close Pig Saddle Road from the junction with Wyndale Road, Waianiwaniwa Road, Malvern Hills Road and Bulls Road to the junction with State Highway 73 from 1.20pm to 4.50pm on Monday 10 November 2014.

The purpose of the proposed road closure is to allow a motorsport event to occur. During the road closure, traffic will be requested to detour along the nearest alternative route.

# Update on Rolleston Railway Station Project

The Selwyn Central Community Board held their second community café evening on 22 July, regarding the beautification project of the Rolleston Railway station.

Further answers were sought from the community members in attendance and a draft garden plan was presented based on the comments from the first meeting. The project continues to receive positive feedback.

“It is great to see that the majority of people in attendance live locally and want to see this project through,” says Selwyn Central Community Board Chairperson Diane Chesmar.

“It’s also exciting to see a variety of different age groups attending these meetings who are keen to be involved too.”

“One of the main comments we have received back is that history is important to the community and we want to include that as part of the beautification project through static image boards outlining the area’s history and connections to the railway for the Selwyn District”, says Mrs Chesmar.

The Board is looking forward to working with the volunteers who have put their names forward to be involved.

The Board is yet to put in for funding towards this project as they are currently working with Kiwirail and their contribution. However, they will work with the community volunteers and will shortly look at putting in funding applications to appropriate organisations.

Board members continue to be actively involved across the District in various projects. Mr Bruce Russell (deputy chair) will continue to focus on the 150th West Melton celebrations and return to the project at a later date.

The Board would like to thank all those involved in this project and those who attended the community meetings and look forward to working with you all.
