Council Services over Easter and Anzac Day

Rubbish and recycling collections normally collected on Good Friday (18 April) and Anzac Day (Friday 25 April) will be collected the next day on Saturday. Collections will occur as normal on Easter Monday (21 April). Pines Resource Recovery Park will be closed on Good Friday (18 April) and Easter Sunday (20 April). The park will be open on Easter Monday (21 April) and Anzac Day (Friday 25 April) from 10am – 4pm.

All Council Libraries and Service Centres are closed Good Friday (18 April), Easter Monday (21 April), and Anzac Day (Friday 25 April). Libraries are open from 9.30am to 12.30pm on Saturday 19 April and 26 April.

The Selwyn Aquatic Centre is open on weekends and public holidays (Good Friday, Easter Monday and Anzac Day) from 8am – 8pm. The Rolleston Community Centre and Lincoln Event Centre are closed on Good Friday (18 April), and Easter Monday (21 April). Both are open on Anzac Day, but only for the time Anzac Day services are held at the centres.

On Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 April the Rolleston Community Centre is open only for previously booked functions. The Lincoln Event Centre is open with normal hours on these days.

Dunsandel Community Facility update

The Dunsandel Hall suffered severe earthquake damage and was demolished. Consultation was undertaken last year with Dunsandel residents as part of a community facility study to determine what the needs are for a new facility and what functional specifications are required to meet the needs of Dunsandel now and in the future.

The study confirmed the functional requirements needed in a new facility so that the Council could proceed to the next phase.

Tenders were invited for architectural services to design a concept plan for a new facility. The tender was awarded to Studio 106 Architect recently.

The company will work on developing a concept plan which is expected to be available in draft form by the middle of this year.
