Over 100 events and activities planned for children in the Selwyn District! The ever popular KidsFest is returning to Selwyn in July. Over 100 events and activities are happening in Selwyn as part of KidsFest, which runs from 4 – 18 July during the school holidays.

"This year we have the biggest line up of activities ever in Selwyn and there are heaps of great events to keep kids entertained when the weather is cold," says Selwyn District Council's Recreation Advisor Dave Tippett. "These include discomania, a high ropes challenge, moviemania, a kids market, kite making, geocaching treasure hunts using GPS and a pool party."

Other KidsFest events in Selwyn include miniature pony fun, ski fun, learn to skateboard, craft sessions, a roller disco, hip hop classes and lots more.

"KidsFest events are organised by Selwyn community groups, the Council and local facilities and each year more exciting activities are being offered in Selwyn," says Mr Tippett.

Some Kidsfest events are free and others are low cost. Booking is required for many events. Kidfest started in 1992 and now runs in Selwyn, Christchurch City and Waimakariri.

Shoulder removal work underway

Work is now underway to improve surface drainage on up to 350km of local roads in Selwyn. The work is being funded from \$530,000 in extra funding provided by the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) to recognise the extra pressure on Selwyn roads from increased traffic as a result of economic and population growth.

Contractors are currently working to remove high grass shoulders along roads to allow water to drain away without ponding on the road surface.

"When the foundations of our roads become wet their strength is reduced and they become more prone to developing potholes or edge damage, particularly on heavy vehicle routes," says Selwyn District Council Assets Manager Murray Washington.

"A way to improve the performance and resilience of Selwyn's typically flat roads and roadsides is

to improve how the road surface drains, especially as our roads are having to deal with more traffic," says Mr Washington.

Shoulder removal is a normal part of the Council's road maintenance programme and is normally done prior to resealing work or when gravel is replaced on unsealed roads. The extra NZTA funding has allowed additional shoulder removal to be done at other sites.

Avoid the AA queues in July

You may have heard that vehicle licensing fees are reducing from 1 July. From this date the ACC levy portion of vehicle licensing fees will reduce by between \$40 and \$170 depending on the type of vehicle.

Because of the coming changes to licensing fees many people have been registering their vehicles so that the license expires in June or July, in order to take advantage of the reduced fees. This means that AA agent offices are likely to be exceptionally busy in July as many people re-license their vehicles.

To beat the queues you can license your vehicle online at www.nzta.govt.nz/online. It is slightly cheaper to license your vehicle online than at an agent but you need to allow time for your new license to be posted to you.

If you decide to renew your car license at an office you can do this at the AA office at the Council's Headquarters in Rolleston (open 8.30am-5pm Monday-Fridays) or at a post shop.

In June, AA agents can process vehicle license applications that apply from 1 July at new reduced fee levels.

LEESTON STORMWATER BYPASS STAGE ONE WORKS

Leeston residents were surveyed in May 2014 on options to upgrade the stormwater system to cope better with heavy rain and reduce the impacts of flooding on the township. 77% of those residents who took part in the survey said they supported work being undertaken on the stormwater system with the option with the most support being to progress with the Leeston North Bypass and investigate options for a Harman's Road extension. Since this survey Council has been reviewing and updating the design for the bypass that was consented by Environment Canterbury in 2007. The first stage of the upgrade works will be undertaken by Grant Hood Contracting starting on site 8 June through to September 2015. These works include upgrading the following drains and culverts:

- · Wetland outlet drain from
- Country Lane wetland Pound Road drain behind 1 and 3 Pound Road
- CDHB drain between Cunningham St and Manse Road
- High St drain between Manse Road and the showground culverts. The showground culvert upgrade is planned for future stages.

Traffic management will be in place on Manse Road and High Street as required during this time. The remainder of the bypass works will be completed in future financial years.
