## Selwyn Community Board News – March 2015

At our recent Board meeting, members received an update explaining notified and non-notified resource consent applications using the 1080 Izone example. Members also received a roading update on both Crown and Council led projects in respect of the Christchurch Southern Motorway Stage 2.

The Chairperson of the Youth Council was also in attendance and provided background on their role in the community.

The Board has recently allocated a number of grants. One of the grants was to Time4Mums to purchase new toys and storage containers. Funding was granted to an individual towards costs of attending the Scout World Jamboree in Japan later this year; and finally a further two grants were made to the Ellesmere Archery Club and TM Dance Committee.

The ANZAC Poppy project that the Board are facilitating has been distributed to local primary schools and a Day Club.

The Board will hold their bi-annual Volunteer Awards on 17 June 2015 during the week of the Volunteer. Nominations will open in May. If you know of anyone who is deserving of a Volunteer Award please fill out a nomination form.

## Fire restrictions lifted

Notice is hereby given that the previously advertised Restricted Fire Season, which extended over the Plains area of the Selwyn District, is lifted as from 8am on Monday 30 March 2015. Fires may be lit in the open air without a fire permit from this date. Restrictions may be re-imposed at a later date if changed weather conditions create a potentially dangerous fire situation.

All residents are requested to take care when lighting open fires due to dry standing grass and vegetation available to carry a fire. Residents are reminded that legal liability for costs associated in fighting an uncontrolled fire lie with the person lighting the fire. Before lighting an open fire, due attention must be given to weather conditions (in particular wind strength), adequacy of firebreaks, and the patrolling of fires until completely out, and it is requested that fires not be lit after dark.

#### Notes:

- 1. A permanent Restricted Fire Season remains in place for the Hill and High Country of the District.
- Property owners are reminded that for the Department of Conservation Estate and Fire Control Areas, fire control measures are in place all year and that organisation should be contacted for a fire permit prior to any burning.
- 3. No fires maybe lit in residential areas without a resource consent from Environment Canterbury.

#### Water restrictions lifted for most areas

Lawn watering restrictions in place for Doyleston, Kirwee, Leeston, Lincoln, Prebbleton and Rolleston have now been lifted, but water restrictions remain in place for West Melton and Springfield.

The restrictions have been lifted as recent rain has helped reduce the demand for water, and water use is expected to be less during autumn as the weather becomes cooler. While residents in these townships can now water their lawns and gardens at any time of the day, the Council still encourages people to consider watering after 9pm and before 6am as this is the time of lowest demand for water and provides the best opportunity for water to soak into the ground, reducing the amount of water needed for irrigation.

Lawn watering restrictions remain in place in Springfield and West Melton, and mean that properties connected to these supplies can't water lawns between 6am-9am and from 4pm-9pm until restrictions are lifted.

In West Melton, several months of low rainfall have depleted groundwater levels. The Council is asking residents to reduce water use in order to avoid more stringent watering restrictions being introduced. While Council infrastructure has the capacity to supply West Melton with more water, the Council like other resource consent holders, has limitations imposed on water use through the consent conditions imposed by Environment Canterbury which it must comply with.

In Springfield, water is drawn from the Kowai River and treated to supply the town. This river is experiencing low flows due to the dry weather of previous


