

On Saturday 5 December, Selwyn residents will have the opportunity to dispose of green garden waste at Hawkins Pit near Darfield.

If you're planning to clean up your garden in the springtime this is a great chance to get rid of garden prunings, tree trimmings or weeds. It costs \$5 per car, ute or single axle trailer to drop off greenwaste, or \$10 for a double axle trailer. General rubbish, soil, cabbage or flax tree leaves, and large trees or braches over 10cm thick can't be disposed of through this service.

Hawkins Pit is located off Cullens Road just east of Bangor Road, about five kilometres from Darfield. The greenwaste disposal service will be operating on Saturday 5 December between 10am and 4pm. A greenwaste disposal day is also planned at Leeston early next year.

Fireworks Safety

With Guy Fawkes this week, we would like to remind Selwyn residents to be safe and considerate if using fireworks.

Two public fireworks displays are being held on Saturday 7 November in Selwyn. The Rolleston Reserve Fireworks evening runs from 5-10.30pm and includes stalls, food, games and rides. Gates open for the Motukarara Fireworks display (held at Waihora Domain, Park Road) from 5.30pm. The Motukarara display also includes free hay rides, live music, pony rides, ice cream, a sausage sizzle, bake sale and bouncy castle. Entry is \$20 per car, or \$5 per person for walk-ins. Public displays are a good way to enjoy fireworks displays without the risk of injury or escaped fires occurring.

Vegetation is becoming dry in Selwyn. If you are planning to use fireworks at home you need to be careful not to allow fireworks to come into contact with hedges, garden shrubs or long grass as if fireworks do contact vegetation this can easily ignite a fire.

If you are using fireworks at home the following safety tips should be followed:

- \cdot Do not light fireworks in windy or hot conditions
- · Follow handling instructions on fireworks carefully
- · Only ignite fireworks in an open space clear of buildings and anything flammable
- · Have a supply of running water at hand, like a garden hose
- \cdot If a firework fails to ignite, do not pick it up and try to reignite it as it could injure you
- · Only adults should use fireworks. Children should stay a safe distance away. Alcohol and fireworks also do not go together
- Keep pets secure inside. Horses and cows can be spooked by fireworks and need to be secured
- Let your neighbours know if you are planning to light fireworks and avoid setting fireworks off at an unreasonable time of night or in the early morning.

Volunteer Fire Forces are normally very busy around Guy Fawkes so please follow the advice above to help avoid starting fires. If you see a fire call 111 to report it.

Sky lanterns, also known as Chinese Lanterns, pose significant fire risk if they are allowed to fly away with a naked flame. You should only use sky lanterns if they are fixed to a spot so they can't float away. More firework safety advice is available on the New Zealand Fire Service website under 'Home Fire Safety.'

On the roads this week

An intersection upgrade is currently taking place to Boundary, Weedons and Lincoln Rolleston Roads. The intersection of Shands and Boundary Roads is also being upgraded.

Road repairs are planned to McDrurys, Robinsons and Barnes Roads and Cunningham Street (between Station and High Streets), with stop and go signs being used by contractors to control traffic.

Road repairs are also planned to Telegraph (between State Highway 1 and Highfield Road), Two Chain and Leeston Lake Roads, which will remain open with traffic controls in place. Work to remove high shoulders along roadsides will take place along Powells, Days and Downs Roads and traffic controls will be in place. Footpath repairs are being made in Lincoln beside Edward Street and Moffat Drive.

This week resealing work is planned along Feredays, Burts, Tramway, Heslerton, Fiddlers, Duck Pond and Ridge Roads. Stop and go signs will be used for traffic control. Maintenance grading work is planned around the Windwhistle, Te Pirita, Dunsandel, Darfield and Kirwee areas, with roads remaining open.

Where work is not completed this week, work will continue next week.
