



This spring and summer Meet Your Street will be visiting 40 different streets in Selwyn giving people a chance to get to know their neighbours.

Meet Your Street is a fun, informal gathering in a local park with free coffee. It's a chance to make new friends, enjoy some music and fun games for kids and adults like joining a giant connect four game. It is being hosted by the Selwyn Youth Council and Selwyn District Council. The Selwyn Youth Council is bringing their coffee kart to the events, giving local young people the opportunity to gain experience running their own business and gaining employment skills.

As Selwyn is New Zealand's fastest growing district, there are lots of new residents in our community. Meet Your Street is a great chance to help people settle in to our district and meet their neighbours in a friendly environment.

If a meet the street event is happening in your area, you'll receive a flyer in your letterbox inviting you to attend which includes a voucher for a coffee or a drink for your family. The first Meet Your Street events in October are happening at these locations with more events planned across Selwyn over summer:

Check the fire danger daily

Over the coming months we will be using the Selwyn District Council website and Facebook page to issue a daily alert advising when the weather means the fire risk is extreme in Selwyn. The fire risk varies day to day and when strong winds combine with hot weather the fire risk becomes extreme.

When this warning is issued we recommend that you:

- don't light outdoor fires
- be careful when operating outdoor machinery as if a spark is ignited this could easily spread and create a fire. You should have a hose connected which can reach the area where you are operating machinery or another method of extinguishing a fire

Older fires can easily reignite in the right weather conditions. If you have lit an outdoor fire in recent months you must carefully check underneath any debris to see if any embers or heat still exists and douse this well with water.

Fires can endanger lives and be costly. We encourage you to check our website every day over spring, summer and autumn to see if the fire warning (which appears as the red banner below on our website homepage) is in place and follow our advice if it is. If you carry out activities which create a fire risk, such as burning or operating machinery, it is particularly important to check the website daily.

Aquatic Centre Swim School Classes Popular

Selwyn Aquatic Centre's Swim School now has around 1,400 children and adults enrolled in classes. Classes are offered at all levels covering babies from six months old to adults.

As a result of the popularity of swim lessons, while lane swimming will still be available at the centre at all times, only one lane will be available in the main pool between 3.30 and 6.30pm from Monday to Friday during each school term. Swimmers who don't want to share a lane with others are being asked to avoid these times.

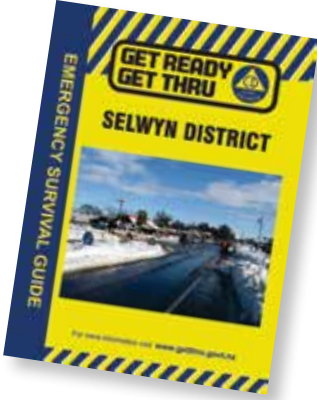
Selwyn Aquatic Facility Manager Kathy Moore says, "We are seeing a large number of children progress from the Learn to Swim pool, to lessons in the main 25m pool and there is a real risk that if we are not able to provide space for them, they will not have the opportunity to enhance their swimming ability."

"We encourage people to call the centre to be advised of the best times for main pool use so they can avoid peak swimming times."

On the roads this week

Road repairs are planned to East Belt, Tancreds, Barnes, McDrury's, Ellesmere and Springs Roads, with stop and go signs being used by contractors to control traffic.

Footpath repairs are being made in Springston beside Ellesmere Junction Road. Work to remove high shoulders along roadsides will take place along Powells and Days Roads and traffic controls will be in place. Traffic controls will also be in place for road repairs to Telegraph Road (between State Highway 1 and Highfield Road) and Leeston and Lake Road.

This week resealing work is planned along Leeston and Lake, Feredays, Pooles, Burts, Tramway, Heslerton and Ridge Roads. Stop and go signs will be used for traffic control.

Maintenance grading work is planned around Southbridge, Killinchy, Motukarara and the high country area with roads remaining open.

LOCAL ALCOHOL POLICY
RECONSIDERATION

The Council's provisional Local Alcohol Policy was notified in January 2014. The policy was appealed by a number of alcohol retailers.

At a hearing in May, the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority asked the council to reconsider policies 1.1 (maximum trading hours for on-licences) and policy 3 (location of licensed premises). The appeals against policy 1.2 (maximum trading hours for off-licences) and policy 4 (discretionary conditions) were dismissed.

The Council is now seeking feedback on policy 1.1 and policy 3. Consultation closes at 5pm **Friday 20 November 2015**. If necessary hearings will be held in early December.
