## Watch out for wasps

If you are out and about, please take care as wasps are a problem at present. Wasp nests typically become larger in the autumn and the insects more mature and aggressive. Children can be stung if they disturb nests so it is a good idea to talk to your children so they can identify what a wasp nest looks like and know to avoid areas with many wasps which are likely to be near nests.

If you see a wasp nest on Council land, please report this to us by phoning 347 2800 or 318 8338 so that it can be destroyed. If you have a problem with a wasp nest on private land you will need to contact a pest control contractor to deal with this.

## New warning signs trialled

New advanced warning signs are now being trialled at two busy rural intersections in Selwyn. The signs illuminate when vehicles approach an intersection and warn there is a stop sign ahead.

The concept for the new signage was developed by Selwyn policeman Dan Harker. The trial is being supported by AMI, Fulton Hogan, Solar Bright, NZTA, the New Zealand Police and Selwyn District Council.

Look out for the new flashing warning signs which will be trialled at Maddisons Road near the Weedons Ross Road intersection and West Melton Road near the Hoskyns Road intersection over the next 18 months. New flashing warning signs will also be installed at Hamptons Road near the Shands Road intersection and on Hoskyns Road near the Sandy Knolls Road intersection in the future.

## On the roads this week

Road repairs are planned to Auchenflower and Malvern Hills Road, with no closures required. Repairs will also be occurring on Rakaia Terrace Road with stop/go controls in place. Footpath repairs will be taking place in the Darfield area, with affected road shoulder closed. Maintenance grading is planned in areas of Malvern Hills, Hororata and West Melton, with no closures planned but motorists are urged to pass with care. Resealing will be taking place on sections of Rakaia Terrace Road and Telegraph road, with stop/go controls in place. Where work is not completed this week it will continue next week.

NZTA is planning repairs to Bealey Bridge on State Highway 73 near Arthur's Pass. The repairs will involve an overnight bridge closure from 10pm to 4am on Saturday 16/ Sunday 17 April. PROPOSED ROAD STOPPING

Section of unformed road, Struie Road Hororata

The Council has received a request from the Campbell Tuer Family Trust for consent to the proposed stopping of an unformed legal road at Struie Road, Hororata and containing a total area of 1.4387 hectares, so that it may be incorporated into their adjacent land.

This section of road serves only the land belonging to the Campbell Tuer farming operation. The land is more particularly described as Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 on the Survey Office Plan SO 470492. The road stopping process is in accordance with Section 345 of the Local Government Act 1974 and has been formally approved by Selwyn District Council by resolution on 8 July 2015. It has also received Ministerial consent under section 342(1)(a) of the Local Government Act 1974.
