

A new arts directory is now available for Selwyn residents. The Selwyn Arts Directory, the first of its kind, is the result of a collaborative effort between the Selwyn Arts Trust and Selwyn District Council and provides a comprehensive list of over 120 artists, arts groups, arts tutors and art galleries across Selwyn district.

Creative New Zealand's Creative Communities Scheme funded the production of the directory.

Selwyn District Council Arts Advisor Rachael Inch says the art directory brings together the visual arts, music, dance, literature, performance, venues, and arts organisations from around the district. "Whether you are looking for tuition for yourself or your child, needing to learn a wedding dance, want to visit a gallery or commission a piece of art for your home or business, it's all in the directory," she says.

Chairperson of the Selwyn Arts Trust, Michael McEvedy is delighted to launch the first edition. "Selwyn has a vibrant arts scene and we are proud to bring it together in the directory for residents to enjoy."

# Trade waste and wastewater bylaw consultation opens

Consultation opens on Wednesday 4 May on new wastewater and trade waste bylaws. Changes to the wastewater bylaw include restrictions on the use of common drains which will affect newly built properties in the future (but not existing properties) and including new clauses into the bylaw which reflect existing practices prohibiting the disposal of non-fibrous or non-biodegradable material, requirements relating to waste minimisation and sustainable management and minimum and prohibited requirements for domestic wastewater. Clauses relating to the potential for wastewater services to be disrupted due to natural hazards or emergencies have also been added.

The trade wastes bylaw affects some commercial businesses operating in Selwyn and regulates the discharge of material which could be harmful to the wastewater network or environment if not managed appropriately. The revised bylaw is largely the same as the previous version except new clauses have been added in requiring that trade wastes be pre-treated, that evidence of regular maintenance of treatment systems be supplied by businesses along with information on how often samples are taken. The Council can also request independent supporting advice from applicants for consents, and undertake technical reviews to reassess and reclassify a discharge.

# District Plan launches in E plan format

The Council's District Plan is now online in an interactive format, making it easier to check what the District Plan rules are that affect your property.

The new format – called an E Plan – makes it easy to look up the zoning of your property and the rules that apply for things like the distance from your garage to property boundary, fencing rules, and what activities are permitted on your property. To use the new plan visit eplan.selwyn.govt.nz and type in your property address. To view the applicable District Plan rules once your property appears choose the 'Show District Plan for' tab. You can also search the 'Search provisions' bar at the top to look for particular topics in the District Plan.

The new format plan replaces the hard copy of the Selwyn District Plan. The paper version of the District Plan was around 1,500 pages in total. The electronic version of the plan makes it easier to find sections applicable to different properties and includes hyperlinks so people can easily refer to other sections referenced in the District Plan.

### On the roads this week

Road repairs and resealing is planned along Rakaia Terrace Road with temporary traffic signals in place. Road repairs are planned for Bethels, Drain and Bealey Roads and Masefield Drive, with traffic controls in place. Road surface levelling is taking place along Cordys Road and Station Street in Leeston, with temporary lane closures occurring while works occur.

Work to extend Broadlands Drive to connect to Springston Rolleston Road and install a new roundabout at the junction is continuing. Temporary speed restrictions are in place. A sewer main is also being laid on Springston Rolleston Road, terminating just before the new roundabout. Temporary traffic signals are in place with short delays for road users especially at peak times. Power cables are being laid underground on Lowes Road, but the road remains open. Tara Bridge (south west of Bush Gully Road) on Malvern Hills Road will be closed from 10-23 May while the bridge deck is replaced.

### Residents Survey now underway

The Council's annual Residents Survey will be carried out from this week until 13 May. The survey is being carried out independently by Versus Research, who will be contacting a number of Selwyn households via telephone or through social media and inviting them to take part in the survey.


### Keep fit over winter

## WASTEWATER DRAINAGE AND TRADE WASTE BYLAWS

Pursuant to Sections 83, 86, 148 and 156 of the Local Government Act 2002; public notice is given that Selwyn District Council resolved at its meeting on 27 April 2016 to invite submissions on the proposal to adopt a new Trade Waste Bylaw and a new Wastewater Drainage Bylaw. The Trade Waste Bylaw relates to the discharge of all trade wastes into the sewerage system. The

Wastewater Drainage Bylaw relates to all discharge of wastewater from any dwelling into the wastewater system.

The Statement of Proposal for each bylaw (including a copy of the proposed bylaws) is available for free inspection from Wednesday 4 May 2016 at the Council offices at 2 Norman Kirk Drive, Rolleston, any Selwyn Library and at www.selwyn.govt.nz.
