This weekend Rolleston will celebrate its official 150th birthday

On the roads this week

East Maddisons Road is open to traffic travelling from Goulds Road to Selwyn Road while work continues to seal the road and complete other works. It is closed to vehicles travelling from Selwyn Road to Goulds Road.

Work is continuing on the shared cycleway/walkway (pictured) between Coalgate and Glentunnel, which is programmed to be finished at the end of this month. The cycleway will also travel over a new bridge being built over the drain near the Hororata Golf course.

Road repairs are planned on Leaches, Bealey, Old Tai Tapu, Marshs and North Rakaia Roads, with traffic controls in place. Road rehabilitation work is planned on Deans Road and berm reconstruction work is planned on Bridge Street, Coalgate with traffic controls in place for both sites. Maintenance grading work will take place in the Hororata, Homebush, Darfield, Killinchy, Bankside and Dunsandel areas.
