

Consultation is now open on our Annual Plan for 2017/18 and we welcome public comments and submissions. Over the next week we have drop in sessions coming up on the plan at these locations:

- · Thursday 13 April: at Darfield Library & Service Centre from 10am-1pm and Rolleston Library from 4-7pm, and
- Tuesday 18 April: at Leeston Library & Service Centre from 9am-12pm and Lincoln Library & Service Centre from 2-5pm.

The sessions are a chance to chat to a Council representative about our Annual Plan. To find out more and make a submission please visit www.selwyn.govt.nz/haveyoursay. We also have a quick five minute survey open on the plan. Completed survey entries will go into a draw to win a \$50 prezzy card. Both submissions and surveys are open until 3 May 2017. We are covering two issues under consultation this week – footpaths and stormwater – with more topics to be covered in April.

Township Footpath location

Extending our footpath network

Last year the Council approved a programme to construct new footpaths to provide better connections to our existing network, by filling in missing sections of footpath in a number of townships.

In 2017/18 we are proposing to carry out more footpath extension work, and by June 2018 we plan to seal the following footpaths at 19 locations which will total 2.3km of new footpaths. If the Council does not increase the funding for footpaths as proposed, some of these important links will not be completed. This work will cost around \$14 per household.

Designing and planning for new pool space

An Aquatic Facilities Plan review has recently been undertaken which identified that additional pool space was needed at the Selwyn Aquatic Centre. The centre currently has 1,550 swim school students enrolled in weekly swim lessons and a waitlist of over 100 students each term. Demand from the community for lane and leisure swimming at the centre is also high. Given these issues an additional multi-use pool is being considered – which is able to be used for swim classes, aquafitness and casual swimmers. This would free up more of the main pool for casual swimmers. Given the popularity of the swim school, additional space is also need for a dedicated Learn to Swim office.

A provisional budget of \$250,000 has been included in next year's Annual Plan to enable feasibility, planning and design work to be undertaken on these additions to the centre. This design work is funded from the swimming pools targeted rate (with no increase in this rate for the 2017/18 year). If there is support for the development of a new pool, a budget for the construction of this would be included in the Long-Term Plan 2018-2028, with the project being scheduled to be completed early on in the plan, due to the high demand for the new pool. Adding new facilities to the centre would be likely to require an increase in the swimming pools rate paid by Selwyn households.

Council Services over Easter

Rubbish and recycling normally collected on Friday 14 April (Good Friday) will be collected on **Saturday 15 April**. Collection on Monday 17 April (Easter Monday) will occur as normal. Pines Resource Recovery Park is closed Friday 14 April, but open from 10am-4pm on Saturday, Sunday and Easter Monday.

Selwyn Libraries will be closed on public holidays over Easter weekend, but open on Saturday 15 April from 9.30am-12.30pm (but service centre functions won't be available on Saturday). Council's Rolleston Headquarters will also be closed from 5pm Thursday 13 April, and reopen on Tuesday 18 April.

The Selwyn Aquatic Centre is open from 8am-8pm daily from Friday 14 April to Monday 17 April, with normal hours resuming on Tuesday 18 April. Rolleston Community Centre and Lincoln Event Centre are closed on Friday 14 April and Monday 17 April.



On the roads this week

Road resurfacing is planned on Telegraph, McLaughlins and Goulds Road (between Lowes and East Maddisons Roads) with stop/go traffic controls operating. Road repairs are planned on Minchins Road, with traffic controls operating. Rehabilitation work (granular overlay) is being done on Bealey Road (between Warrens and Essendon Roads) with traffic controls operating.

A sewer line is being installed on sections of Hamptons, Shands and Selwyn Road to the intersection of Springston Rolleston Road. There may be a reduction down to one lane on these roads.

Work to complete road repairs from a burst water main is planned at the Tennyson, Byron and Kidman Street roundabout from Tuesday 18 – Friday 21 April approximately. Detours will be in place.

Christchurch Southern Motorway extension

From Monday 10 April – Monday 17 April, access to Weedons Ross Road between State Highway One and Jones Road will be one-way. Traffic will be able to travel on the road from State Highway One towards Jones Road but not from Jones Road to State Highway One. From Monday 17 April the sections of Weedons Ross Road between State Highway One and Jones Road, and Weedons Road between State Highway One and Levi Road will be closed both ways to traffic. A closure will also be in place on Weedons Road from Main South Road through to Levi Road. The closures are to allow cables to be laid as part of the Christchurch Southern Motorway extension project. Detours will be clearly sign-posted.

Reduced speed limits continue to be in place along State Highway One north of Rolleston where work is continuing to four lane this section of road. Speed limits and traffic management are in place for safety reasons. Exceeding the speed limits or driving in an unsafe manner around these sites puts other road users and road workers at risk. Police will be monitoring this site.

Pothole repairs underway

When our district experiences a significant amount of rain this affects our roading network. Damp conditions affects road bases and roads are more prone to damage from vehicles during wet weather. A number of potholes have appeared on our road network following last week's rain.

ADOPTION OF LOCAL ALCOHOL POLICY

The Council's Provisional Local Alcohol Policy has been reconsidered by the Alcohol Licensing and Regulatory Authority who are satisfied that the provisions of the policy are not unreasonable in light of the object of the Act. Accordingly all appeals against the policy have been disposed of in their entirety.

Pursuant to Section 87 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act

2012 the policy is now adopted and ceases to be provisional. The policy (apart from the provisions relating to maximum trading hours which effect licensed premises) come into force on 24 April 2017. The provisions of the policy
