Precautionary Boil Water Notice: Darfield

Residents on the Darfield water supply are advised to continue boiling water.

Sunday, 29th December 2013 test results have today returned clear samples.

The Council is undertaking daily water testing and only after three clear days of results the Boil Water Notice can be lifted. Today's result is the second clear sample.

When a boil water notice is in place, the Ministry of Health advises that people should boil all water from taps before drinking, brushing teeth or using it in food preparation. In addition, water used to make ice should also be boiled before freezing.

Water will need to continue to be boiled until the precautionary Boil Water Notice is lifted.
