Boil water notice lifted for Arthur's Pass Water Supply

Residents connected to the Arthur's Pass water supply are advised they no longer need to boil water.

A boil water notice was issued for this supply for turbidity as rainfall disturbed the water supply intake. When a water supply shows high turbidity, water treatment methods cannot be guaranteed to be effective.

Selwyn District Council's Team Leader Water Services Andy Olivier, says that the water supply turbidity levels have now lowered which means the treatment systems can operate effectively. The water samples taken are clear of *E.coli*. The water is safe to drink without boiling.

The Council wishes to thank residents for their patience while the notice was in place.
