Boil Water Notice: Springfield Supply

Resident who are on the Springfield Water Supply are advised to immediately begin boiling water.

Heavy rainfall has occurred in recent days. This has increased the turbidity of the Springfield water supply.

No *E.coli* has been detected in the water supply. However as result of the increased turbidity, the Council cannot guarantee the water is safe to drink and as a precaution has issued a boil water notice.

Springfield residents will need to boil their water for at least 3 minutes until further notice.

Chlorination of the water supply has been increased and will continue until further notice.

The council will continue to monitor the intake and reticulation system and keep residents informed.
