Boil water notice lifted for Arthur's Pass Water Supply

Residents connected to the Arthur's Pass Water supply are advised they no longer need to boil water.

A boil water notice was issued for this supply on 19 March, after testing found that E.coli was above recommended levels.

Selwyn District Council's Strategic Asset Manager: Utilities, Murray England, says that the Council has received enough test results showing that the water is now clear of E.coli for it to be safe to drink.

The Council wishes to thank residents for their patience while the notice was in place.
