## **Boil water notice lifted for Selwyn Rural Water Supply**

Residents connected to the Selwyn Rural water supply are advised they no longer need to boil water. The water supply services Hororata and the surrounding area.

A boil water notice was issued for this supply for turbidity as rainfall and snow melting disturbed the water supply intake. When a water supply shows high turbidity, water treatment methods cannot be guaranteed to be effective.

Selwyn District Council's Team Leader Water Services Andy Olivier, says that the water supply turbidity levels have now lowered and that the water is safe to drink without boiling.

The Council wishes to thank residents for their patience while the notice was in place.
