Boil water notice lifted for Springfield Water Supply

Residents connected to the Springfield supply are advised they no longer need to boil water.

A boil water notice was issued for this water supply on Monday 22 April following heavy rainfall which increased the turbidity of the water supply intake. When a water supply shows high turbidity, water treatment methods cannot be guaranteed to be effective.

Selwyn District Council's Strategic Asset Manager: Utilities, Murray England, says that test results from the water supply show that the water is safe to drink.

The Council wishes to thank residents for their patience while the notice was in place.
