Boil water notice lifted for Selwyn Rural Water Supply

Residents connected to the Selwyn Rural Water supply are advised they no longer need to boil water. The water supply services Hororata and the surrounding area.

Selwyn District Council's Strategic Asset Manager: Utilities, Murray England, says that the Council has received enough test results showing that the water is clear of E.coli for it to be safe to drink.

The Council wishes to thank residents for their patience while the notice was in place.

The Council will continue to chlorinate the water supply for a number of days and recommends that people connected to this supply disinfect their own water tanks if they have not already done so.
