No need to boil water now in Malvern Hills Dalethorpe

Residents in Malvern Hills/ Dalethorpe are advised they no longer need to boil water as testing has shown the water is safe to drink.

Selwyn District Council Utilities Officer Lisa Duder says the Malvern Hills Dalethorpe water supplies have had sufficient water samples that have been clear of E.coli.

Council asks that residents speak to their neighbours so that everyone is aware the boil water notice has been lifted. The Council also wishes to thank residents for their patience.
