Ready to have a go?

Selwyn residents will be able to 'have a go' at a huge variety of sports and recreation activities at this year's Have a Go Day.

Event organiser Selwyn District Council has confirmed the free annual event, now in its third year, will return on Sunday 27 August between 12 and 3pm at the Lincoln Event Centre and Domain.

Senior Events and Recreation Advisor Dave Tippet says, "Have a Go Day aims to showcase the sport and recreation activities Lincoln and the wider Selwyn District has to offer. Last year it was a very popular event with over 1000 people enjoying a day of trying out new things."

Nearly 30 indoor and outdoor sports, activities, games and challenges are planned, including pedalmania, SNAG golf, hockey, rugby league, highland games, yoga, basketball, archery, spin, mini gym, flips and tumbles, and much more.

Those attending the event will receive a 'Have a Go Day passport' on arrival. Everyone who completes five challenges can get their passport stamped and enter the main prize draw for a chance to win \$250 in sport vouchers.

Coffee, a sausage sizzle, and live music will be provided as part of the entertainment.
