A new Selwyn District Council information guide will start being delivered to Selwyn homes soon.

The 30 page booklet is an A-Z guide of council facilities and services. It includes information on how to access commonly used services, links to online resources and Council and emergency contacts.

“We recognise that Selwyn has been growing very quickly which makes it difficult for residents to be fully informed about all the council services that are available, so we have produced this guide,” says Selwyn Mayor Kelvin Coe.

The Council provides a wide range of services to the 45,000 residents living in Selwyn – from libraries, to water and roads, parks, civil defence, rubbish and recycling collection and animal control.
