Have your say on Rolleston's future now

Selwyn residents are invited to attend two upcoming drop in sessions on Rolleston's future development. The sessions are being held on:

- Wednesday 16 October – from 5-8pm at the Council Headquarters, Rolleston
- Sunday 20 October – from 1.30-4.30pm at Rolleston Community Centre.

The sessions are part of the consultation currently underway on the development of the Rolleston Town Centre and Foster Recreation Park.

The consultation includes proposals to develop Tennyson Street as Rolleston's main street, build a new library, community and technology centre, create a town square and develop Foster Recreation Park as a large sport and recreation park. These projects would be staged over the next 20 years, with further consultation needed on the costs of individual projects.

Council planners will also be hosting a *site tour on Saturday 19 October from 2 -3pm* which will explain how the Rolleston Town Centre could develop when the new library, main street and town square are constructed.
