Selwyn Aquatic Centre turns four

This month marks the fourth anniversary of the opening of the Selwyn Aquatic Centre, which will be celebrated with a Birthday Bonanza event.

More than 1.1 million admissions to the Centre have been recorded since its opening in June 2013.

Aquatic Facilities Manager, Kathy Moore says, "The Selwyn Aquatic Centre is used for a wide variety of community events and programmes such as swim meets, sports club trainings, family fun pool parties, disability care, injury recovery and aquafit classes, as well as the Swim School which provides swimming lessons for all ages and abilities. Currently over 1500 children attend weekly swim lessons."

The Birthday Bonanza event is being held on Sunday 25 June from 2–4pm. A variety of fun activities will be on offer for the whole family, including inflatables, games, colouring in competition, music, sweet treats, chalk drawing, spot prizes, cake and more. Normal pool admission fees will apply.
