Faringdon Sensational Selwyn Awards Nominations close soon

Nominations close on 20 June for the Faringdon Sensational Selwyn Awards 2014.

The awards are held every two years and recognise and honour outstanding Selwyn businesses, community groups and individuals for their inspirational work and achievements.

The awards are organised by Selwyn District Council with Faringdon as the naming sponsor. Nominations can be made in nine categories:

- Sports
- Tourism
- Young Achiever
- The Diana Isaac Cup (for native planting in the Selwyn District)

The awards recognise excellence, innovation and service. They are open to individuals and organisations who live, or are based, in the Selwyn district and meet the criteria for entry listed on nominations forms. Although 2012 award winners are not eligible to enter the same category, they can enter one of the other categories this year. Award nominees must give permission to be entered on the entry form.

The Awards will be announced at a gala dinner at the Lincoln Event Centre on Saturday 26 July. Ticket sales for the awards dinner open on 16 June and close 16 July.
