School holiday fun in Selwyn

There are plenty of interesting activities for children happening in Selwyn these school holidays.

The Selwyn Aquatic Centre, Selwyn libraries, and Lincoln Event Centre are holding events over the two week school holiday break beginning on 28 September.

Selwyn Aquatic Centre is holding a Spring Pool Fest. Sessions run from 1-3pm from Monday 28 September until Friday 2 October. On Monday and Wednesday there will be a large inflatable obstacle course and slide in the main pool for children eight years and onwards. On Tuesday and Thursday Volleyball nets and balls will be available for use in the learners pool, and on Friday Flippa Ball sessions for year 4-7 primary students will run including lessons on skills and game play. Standard pool entry costs apply.

Selwyn Libraries will have events and displays to celebrate Diwali and Indian culture. Free Indian Culture Craft and Henna/Zentangle Craft are being held at all four libraries. Children can also attend Science Alive sessions, which cost \$9 for the Illuminating session and \$7 for the Boredom Busters session.
