

Uploading required documents into AlphaOne

1. Save the document to your computer/device

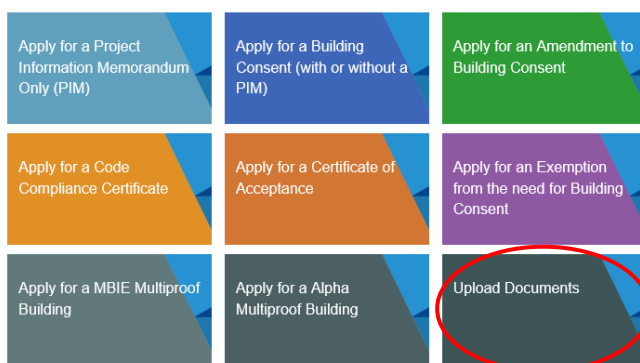
The document needs to be saved as a **pdf file** - e.g.

- BCnumber_asbulldp_YYYYMMDD.pdf
- BCnumber_trusscertificate_YYYYMMDD.pdf
- BCnumber_PS4raftslab_YYYYMMDD.pdf

2. Log into AlphaOne



3. Click on upload documents



4. Use the search function to find the building consent – enter the consent number and click on Go
