The soil type is Templeton Silt Loam, which is free draining.

The land classification is Green Zone Unmapped/Rural

The zoning is Inner Plains.

Having lived in the Ladbrooks area all his life, owning and leasing farmland, Ivan has extensive knowledge of the Selwyn and broader area.

Our property is close to several subdivisions currently under development on the corner of Robinsons Road and Springs Road and two on Birchs Road close to Lincoln township.

Our property is located close to both Lincoln and Prebbleton townships which provide primary and secondary schooling and local amenities.

The property has the advantage of having access from both Robinsons and Birchs Roads. We anticipate approximately 36 one hectare blocks.

Another advantage is that our property is within 900 metres from the main sewer line in Robinsons Road.

Storm water disposal would be stored in tanks and the free draining soil would take overflow.
