The draft Rural Residential Strategy will help to inform the extent of rural residential development in the district and to manage its cumulative adverse effects through appropriate changes to the district plan to implement the strategy. The development of the Rural Residential Strategy is supported by Method (3) to Policy 6.3.9 to Chapter 6 of the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement 2013.

The draft strategy provides a robust framework for the identification of preferred rural residential sites in the district and achieving appropriate outcomes for such development. The framework is consistent with the outcomes sought in Policy 6.3.9 to Chapter 6 of the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement 2013.

The draft strategy together with changes to the district plan will put in place a framework for the management of rural residential development and in so doing help give effect to the objectives and policies of the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement 2013. This includes the recovery, urban form and settlement objectives of Chapter 6 which seek to provide sufficient land for the rebuild and recovery of greater Christchurch, and achieving the consolidation of urban areas. Chapter 6 also seeks the appropriate integration of development with infrastructure including the transport network. The Rural Residential Strategy will help the district council achieve these outcomes by managing rural residential development in the district.

The Canterbury Regional Council agrees with the Statement of Proposal for the Strategy and the reasons stated for the preparation of the strategy. In particular Method (3) to Policy 6.3.9 to Chapter 6 supports the development of the Rural Residential Strategy to inform the extent of rural residential activity and outcomes sought for this form of development within the district.
