BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF NOTICE:	Notice of Requirement pursuant to s181 (1) for the alteration of a designation reference NZTA-1 in the Partially Operative Selwyn District Plan (POSDP) to construct an overpass and associated state highway infrastructure.	
LEGAL DESCRIPTION:	The requirement applies to approximately 68,803m² of land located North and South of State Highway 1 (SH1) and east to west of SH1.	

The Notice of Requirement

- 1. This Notice of Requirement (NOR) was formally received by the Selwyn District Council on 30 November 2024. Further information was received on 21 February and 8 May 2025, and this information now forms part of the application.
- 2. The NOR to alter designation NZTA-1 in the Partially Operative Selwyn District Plan (POSDP) is for the purpose of constructing an overpass and associated state highway infrastructure.
- 3. The works comprise the construction and operation of the balance of the Rolleston Access Improvements including an overpass of SH1 connecting Rolleston Drive North and Jones Road, changes to nearby intersections (including Hoskyns Rd, Tennyson St, and Rolleston Drive South) and associated works:
 - Closure of the existing intersection of SH1 and Rolleston Drive North and the construction of an overpass, over SH1 and the railway, to connect to Jones Road, with walking and cycling facilities.
 - A new exit lane from SH1 southbound to Rolleston Drive North and a new service lane, to improve access to the Rolleston town centre, highway amenities and suburbs.
 - Left turn only access / egress at Tennyson Street, Brookside Road, and Rolleston Drive South.
 - A left turn only egress from Hoskyns Road onto SH1 northbound.
 - Various ancillary works including, but not limited to, the construction of stormwater detention basins, reconfiguration of property access and associated road works within the local road network.

Public Notification

- 5. The requiring authority has requested that the application be publicly notified.
- 6. Pursuant to section s149ZCB(2)(b)) of the Resource Management Act 1991, the consent authority must notify an application for a resource consent if so requested by the requiring authority.
- 7. It is therefore recommended that the application be publicly notified pursuant to section 149ZCB of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 8. Section 2AA of the Resource Management Act sets out that public notification means the following:

- 10. Notice of the application is to be served on every prescribed person, as set out in clause 10(2) of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedure) Regulations 2003 as follows:
 - (2) The consent authority must serve that notice on—
 - (a) every person who the consent authority decides is an affected person under section 95B of the Act in relation to the activity that is the subject of the application or review:

(b) every person, other than the applicant, who the consent authority knows is an owner or occupier of land to which the application or review relates:
