It would be amazing if we had a park that we could make use of that was fit for our purposes. It would also be great if there was a locked area that we could potentially store a small amount of gear. Fistball does not need a lot equipment but it does require a big space to play on.

The pitch is 50 metres by 25 metres and also needs a run off area. The area doesn't have to be lined as we can use cones so can fit within a normal football or rugby pitch.

I am on the Canterbury and NZ board for Fistball and we have already held two international competitions in Canterbury as well as having a Canterbury league that normally runs year-round at different venues. As with everyone, Covid has significantly affected our domestic league and international plans this year.

Our most pressing need is for training grounds in winter when we have an international coming up. This becomes particularly hard in winter when most lit fields are set aside for Rugby and Football and as generally World Champs are played in the Northern Hemisphere summer, we have to train outside on grass in winter to make sure we are as competitive as possible.

We would like to be able to use the grounds at Prebbleton but don't have specific needs other than space on an already established and lit Football or Rugby field. While we don't ask for this to be set aside for us it would be nice if there could somehow be a field kept free for sports other than rugby and football over winter to use.
