My/Our Submissions is: : This submission has been made in response to the effects this change would have on the ramous Grouse Hotel at Lincoln. Should PC 12 in its present form be adopted an increase in the numbers of required purking for the 30 required under an existing Resource Consent to approximately 75 (E13.1.b+ E13.1.1.4) would occur on this site.

This encourages unsustainable use of private motor vehicles.
