Submission on publicly notified, Plan Change 7. Selwyn District Plan. Don Wright

- We have serious concerns about our position regarding Plan Change 7 and the proposed 'Living Z' zone. We would prefer that Springston-Rolleston Road be given immediate development and high density status (Stage 1). This could be done by adding the land on the southern side of the road to the proposed SR6 and SR7 zones. Or creating new sub-zones SR6A and SR7A with some different conditions, if necessary. It is realised that the the existing population densities are different and that it is easier for planners and developers to deal with as few owners as possible, however, a glance at the map shows that the three areas are inextricably joined and are virtually one. Logic suggests that the whole area should be developed at the same time. The proposed upgrading of Springston-Rolleston Road to become a main leader road with a bus route, very close to the Recreational Precinct, High School and Neighborhood shopping centre as well as the SR6 and SR7 zones seems to suggest that S/R Road and SR'6s & 7 should be developed at approximately the same time..
- I question the absolute need for development to occur only along a narrow front, simply because a single owner has a relatively large area of unoccupied land for sale. It was only a short time ago that Rolleston was spreading like wildfire both north and south along State Highway1.
- ♦ Long term residents of Springston-Rolleston Road have always considered themselves to be part of, and belonging to, the Rolleston community. We have served on committees and made constructive submissions to Consent Hearings over the 20 year period that has seen the town mushroom.(See attached appendices).
- ♦ The key to any future development, including the SR6 and SR7 zones, according to the Rolleston Draft Structure Plan, depends on installing the main sewerage line to the new Southern Pumping Station i.e. along Springston-Rolleston Road. It is planned to turn S/R Road into a tree-lined avenue with lateral and central tree-planting. According to the RDS Report this planting should be done sooner rather than later. With the existing water race on the north side of the road, widening might be expected to take place on the south side
- ♦ The notion that Springston-Rolleston Road is 'some' distance from the SR6 & SR7 zones, must be challenged. For many of us it is a nice easy walk which we do on a daily basis, just for exercise. (RDSP page 111)
- ♦ If the planned Recreational Precinct is going to attract hungry sports supporters as suggested, where better to go for sustenance than to the nearest Neighborhood Centre on S/R Road just a very short walk away.
- ♦ Many of us along Springston-Rolleston Road still have septic tanks, which in March 1995 was a **powerful reason** for getting Resource Consent for a central collection, treatment and disposal systems. We along S/R Road were all in the **headcount** for getting that consent granted.
- ◆ Upgrading and widening the road, planting the trees, putting in the sewer line, water reticulation and fibre optic cables, establishment of the necessary residential setbacks from the road. etc., might all be expected to be done at the same time. Now. Rather than in bits and pieces somewhere down the track. I believe in consultation with the locals affected, and perhaps some financial input from them, it could be done now. I would like to see Springston-Rolleston Road, developed early and as the perfect example of what the new ROLLESTON concept is really all about. (See the RSP)







My submission in opposition is:

I oppose the repositioning of the air noise contours due to the constraining effect it will have on the future use of my property.

The repositioned contours do not reflect the existing uses occurring within this location. Assumptions have been made that all land within the inner plains zone is consistent with the activities promoted within this zone, however no cognisance has been given to existing activities and environments that are not consistent with the inner plains zoning.

Due to this assumption, the proposed new air noise contours will impinge my ability to give any weight to the existing character and amenity of the current environment when assessing the future use of my property.

The property was purchased in the knowledge that future use would not be constrained by the air-noise contours. Being in close proximity to the territorial authority boundary as well a raft of non-rural activities we were aware that exceptional circumstances where in existence that would be given weight when considering potential activities on the site. The proposal to relocate the air noise contours will negate these circumstances, which were so fundamental in our decision to acquire this site.

I seek the following decision from Selwyn District Council:

Provide a mechanism through objectives, policies and rules, whereby exceptions can be considered and the appropriate weight given to the existing character of the receiving environment when determining the merits of activities sensitive to noise within the air/noise contour.

Without such a mechanism, the air-noise contours become an influential tool that over-rides the effects-based arguments that would ordinarily carry significant weight in any other location outside the air/noise contour. Furthermore, without the ability for such exceptions to be considered, the ability to apply discretion when deciding on activities that are not permitted becomes severely limited.

- 2. The specific provisions of the proposal that my submission relates to are;
 - a. The move of Council from 'market-led' approach to an apparent 'community-led' approach, through the RSP.
 - b. The extensive use Outline Development Plan Areas to govern the future development of the Rolleston township area.
 - c. The introduction of Living Z zoning, and large predetermined areas proposed for rezoning namely Outline Development Plan Area 5 & Outline Development Plan Area 6 along Gould's Road.
- 3. My submission is in OPPOSITION to these aspects of the plan and I wish to have them amended for the following reasons:

As a resident of Rolleston I have submitted in good faith in support of the draft Regional Policy Statement and on the development of the Rolleston Structure Plan. However in doing so I am now very concerned to identify that I have not had full access to information provided by the Council in respect of urban limits and development proposals for Rolleston. Therefore, I find I can no longer support the Rolleston Structure Plan in its current form as translated into Plan Change 7 for the following reasons:

1. The Council has stated an intention to adopt a strategic based approach to planning for the development of the Rolleston township and has decided on a 'community-led' rather than 'market led' approach to development. I understand the decision to take this approach has been based on previous experiences in the apparent disjointed development of subdivisions which lack a 'wider community connectivity' favored by Council planners.

The principles of the 'community-led' approach adopted by the Council are stated to be initiated through the preparation of structure plans for township areas. This approach is

also reported to be achieved through the extensive use of Outline Development plan Areas now prescribed in Plan Change 7 (Page 3).

At the same time as promoting the structure plans as a 'community-led' approach, Plan Change 7 steps back from the structure plans. The decision to step back from the structure plans is indicated in the following statement 'Like the Lincoln Structure Plan, the RSP is not intended to act as a blueprint. The ultimate form of development will not look exactly like the structure plan but will be guided by the concepts and approach of the structure plan'. (page 17, 5.26 of SDP).

In stepping back from the structure plan and in development of Plan Change 7 and extensive use of Outline Development Plans, the Council has moved to a heavily prescriptive 'Council-led' approach to development, rather than being either truly market driven or community led.

- 2. The Rolleston Structure Plan lists a number of key principles which are no longer evident from the proposals outlined in Plan Change 7. In 5.33 (page 21, SDC Volume 1) the Council notes there needs to be different land ownerships available in each stage of development. This is to ensure competition and to avoid 'land banking' whereby one owner controls the release of land for development. Plan Change 7 does not provide for these principles.
- 3. Challenges presented by development include;
 - a. Enabling a reasonable degree of competition within the land market (e.g. development opportunities not cornered by one land owner).
 - b. Promote effective use of existing urban land, as well as the land to be released.

Plan Change 7 does not deal with either of these challenges in relation to the Outline Development Plans and the inclusion of Living Z zoning as proposed. The outline development plans cover a few large privately owned blocks of land and thereby does not achieve significant principles as outline in the structure plan. Very significant

financial benefits will arise from the development of these large privately owned blocks of land as currently outlined in PC7.

4. Through plan Change 7 the Council is also stating it is providing for the future development of ratepayer funded recreational facilities through the provision of a 'Recreational Precinct' near Goulds Road and Dynes Road. In plan Change 7 the Council develops Zone Z deferred land for the development of this precinct.

The rezoning of this area to Zone Z deferred land preempts any meaningful community consultation on the future of facilities within this precinct. No sound reasonable cost benefit analysis has been provided, and therefore there has been no genuine consultation with Rolleston ratepayers (either existing or future) on whether or not they wish to rate fund indoor and outdoor sports facilities, heated indoor swimming pools, sports club headquarters, and outdoor community (youth) park sports fields and hard courts. A proposed High School is also reported to be located with the recreational precinct.

Given that the area proposed for the Recreational Precinct is owned by one landowner (ODP5) who also owns significant parts of the area proposed for residential development through ODP6, the council is ensuring that significant financial benefits will accrue to very few members of the community through development of ODP5 and ODP6. This is counter to the principles of the District Plan and structure plan.

In my view the proposal to develop the Goulds Road and Dynes Road block as a Recreational Precinct (ODP5) and residential development (ODP6) is highly premature. ODP5 should not go ahead until sufficient future ratepayers of Rolleston are living in the area. These are the people who will be supporting the continued running of these facilities through their rates. Development should only go ahead after appropriate community consultation where development and on-going maintenance costs of these facilities are clearly known. These facilities will need to be funded from the rating pool and any rates increases associated with this recreational precinct should be clearly identified and understood by residents.

- 5. I support the development of areas along East Maddisons Road and Goulds Road prior to or at the same time as the development of ODP5 and ODP6. If these areas on the inner section of Rolleston are not addressed prior to or in conjunction with the development of ODP6 then new housing owners in ODP6 will express considerable dissatisfaction with the undeveloped, rural and older style housing across the road. The properties which will remain zoned as Inner Plains along East Maddisons Road and Goulds Road and will create reverse sensitivities for new residents coming into the area. Development of these areas must be considered at the same time as development of ODP5 and ODP6 to ensure Rolleston remain an attractive and well planned town.
- 6. The southern area of the proposed ODP6 development currently backs onto an extension of East Maddisons Road. This s currently a rural, unkept, small single road that extends some 3 kms to Selwyn Road. This road is currently rarely used. Development of ODP6 along this section of east Maddisons Road will require the sealing of half of this road and will result in additional traffic flow into the undeveloped inner plans area of East Maddisons Road. This will add to existing dangers and problems encountered at the intersection of East Maddisons and Goulds Road. The inner section of East Maddisons Road which is proposed to remain Inner Plains currently supports a large number of horses and riders which adds to the danger at this intersection.
- 7. As a landowner in this area, I am aware the Council has made no attempt to approach other landowners in the vicinity of the proposed Recreational Precinct (ODP5) or ODP6 seeking contributions of land for recreational and community development purposes. For this reason I cannot support Plan Change 7 in relation to ODP5 and ODP6 in its current form.

4. I seek the following decision from the Selwyn District Council

- a. That the section of East Maddisons Road currently zoned as Inner plains be rezoned as Living Z deferred.
- b. That an allocation of 200-300 houses proposed in Plan Change 7 for ODP6 be reallocated along the East Maddisons Road.
- c. That the Council includes the inner section of East Maddisons Road (both sides) in Living Z zoning for ODP6, providing landowners in that area with an opportunity to subdivide or provide land for recreational and community development purposes.
- d. That the Council considers options for adequate development of the larger sized sections running along the inside of East Maddisons and Goulds Road to prevent reverse sensitivities arising from new landowners investing in residential land in ODP6.
- e. That the Council reconsiders Plan Change 7 in light of the principles of the District Plan, and reconsiders the development of large areas proposed for rezoning in Outline Development Plan Area 5 & Outline Development Plan Area 6 along Gould's Road.

Our submission in Opposition is:

The revised location of the 50dBA Ldn Air Noise Contour fails to address the effects on existing dwellings in the Inner Plains zone.

We are concerned that this Air Noise Contour will result in a substantial increase in perceived noise at existing dwellings within the Contour boundaries. The emphasis in the Plan Change appears to be to protect the Airport Company's rights to operate without "unreasonable restrictions that could affect its activities". There is no consideration given to effects on existing dwellings.

We understand that the 50dBA Ldn contour provides for a substantial increase in the number of flights than are existing and therefore as time goes on the noise will be greater than that which exists at present. We would like to stress that we are not concerned at the existing noise and we do accept that the rural environment has some noise. However, we want to register that we do no wish to lose our rights to comment if there is a decrease in amenity due to increased flights and consequently night time noise in the future.

We seek the following decision from Selwyn District Council:

We understand that if this Plan Change is approved, a note will be placed on a LIM for our property recording that the noise contours affect our property and the associated restrictions on development. We also understand from discussions with Council staff that our submission is unlikely to change anything, as it is merely to be in accordance with the Regional Policy Statement. This is hardly a consultative process.

We are concerned that such a major change to future property rights, through the Regional Council process should have been imposed with only public notification through the newspapers and that individual property owners affected by the Regional Plan change were not notified. It is disappointing that Selwyn District Council did not see fit to assist its ratepayers as part of this process.

The review of the noise contours needs to acknowledge the existing dwellings within the Coutour and their right to amenity of their properties. This may be by decreasing the noise limits, which are substantially higher than the existing noise. We would also seek deletion of the controls of further residential development of the land. It is considered that requirements for noise insulation of new dwellings would provide for the quiet night time noise standards that should apply in a rural area.

We would be happy to discuss with Council staff how they have balanced the wishes of the Airport Company with the amenity issues of their ratepayers. We have lived at our property at Trents Road for over 30 years and definitely cannot be considered in the category of people that have come to the nuisance.
