## Submission Points for Plan Change 24 (Silverstream)

- 1. Access required from SH73 to proposed B2 land.
- 2. Green space for recreation purposed required.
- 3. Ultimately no heavy traffic should be allowed on Mathias/Cardale Street (refer point 1)
- Acoustic fence may not be required if trees & shrubs are adequate.
- 5. Road widths should be wider to be in keeping with the rest of Darfield.
- Road widths should be wider to ensure Fire Engines etc can get access. Please take
