I endorse Eugenie Sage's submission point 2, that the applications are premature and should be placed on hold until DoC has notified its decision on the applicants' proposal to access conservation land. The applications should also be placed on hold until notified by Environment Canterbury to jointly consider the applications by both Councils, if Blackfish Ltd is successful in freeholding the land.

4. The reasons for my **OPPOSITION** are:

Submissions 137 and 2139 and all the similar submissions contribute nothing substantial to the Plan Change Request. They indicate a low level of understanding of the RMA process and the adverse impacts of the proposal on the environment. Submissions such as these 'clog up' the system and make the process unnecessarily time consuming and expensive for other submitters.

I oppose the amendments by Porter Heights Ski Area Ltd #1719 as they do not go far enough in reducing the adverse effects of the proposal. The village development is inappropriate for an area valued for its Outstanding Natural Landscape.

I seek the following decision from Selwyn District Council:

Disregard the form submissions which contain no unique contribution to the Plan Change request. Decline the applications as stated in my original submission.
