

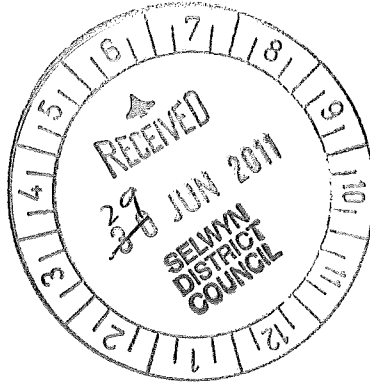

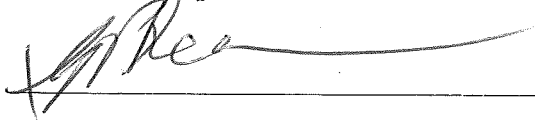
I am not in favour of the proposed plan change 26.
