

## Private Plan Change Request - Plan Change 3

Clause 5 of the First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991

Plan Change 3 to the Selwyn District Plan (Township Volume) proposes to rezone approximately 85 hectares of existing urban zoned land to the west of Weedons Ross Road and north of State Highway 73 to a new Living WM (West Melton) zone to enable the subdivision and development of the land which is currently zoned for urban purposes but on a deferred basis. The key changes proposed by Plan Change 3 include:

- Mixed density residential development (ranging from average allotment densities of <1,150m<sup>2</sup> to >5,000m<sup>2</sup>).
- A residential yield of 280 allotments.
- Incorporation of an Outline Development Plan with which subdivision and development shall accord.
- Road connections to Halkett Road, Weedons Ross Rd and State Highway 73.
- Defined internal road pattern and provision for partial off street pedestrian and cycle routes.
- Public open space and reserve running west to east through the middle of the site, with further reserve areas being located adjacent to Weedons Ross Rd.
- Internal stormwater conveyance and treatment system with sewage disposal to be provided by connecting to the existing West Melton to Rolleston sewer pipeline.

Any submitter who is not satisfied with the Council's decision may then appeal to the Environment Court.
