PRIVATE PLAN CHANGE 44

Dreamtime Limited request to rezone Rural (Inner Plains) land to Living 3 at 1535 Main South Road, Rolleston.

Selwyn District Council
Clause 5 of the First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991

Private Plan Change Dreamtime Limited (PC 44) proposes to change the Selwyn District Plan (Rural and Township Maps and Plan Text) to rezone 20.59 ha of existing Rural (Inner Plains) land to Living 3 zone to facilitate the subdivision and development of approximately 36 rural residential households. The subject land is located at 1535 Main South Road, Rolleston. The property is generally bound by SH1 to the north, and Devon Park subvision to the west. PC 44 proposes the following amendments to the Selwyn District Plan:

- Amends the District Planning Maps to rezone the subject land to a Living 3 zone
- Incorporates an Outline Development Plan to coordinate and guide the future development
 of the site
- Incorporates land use rules and subdivision assessment matters to manage the effects of any future development on the site in accordance with the proposed amendments to the Living 3 zone provisions

A hard copy of the plan change request is available for viewing at Council's Rolleston Headquarters.

Further Submissions will then be invited, allowing any person or organisation to support or oppose any of the initial submissions. A Council hearing will then be arranged to consider all submissions, after which the Council will decide whether to reject or approve the plan change. Any submitter who is not satisfied with the Council's decision may then appeal to the Environment Court.
