PLAN CHANGE 59

At its meeting on 10 March 2021, the Selwyn District Council resolved to accept the Commissioner's recommendation to approve GW Wilfield Ltd's request to rezone Living 2 and Living 2A Zone land in West Melton to a new zone called 'Living WM South'. The location to which this request relates is on the south side of West Coast Road/State Highway 73, bounded by Weedons Ross Road to the west.

This decision has legal effect from the date of this notice and the Operative District Plan is deemed amended in accordance with this decision.

Anyone who made a submission on Plan Change 59 may appeal to the Environment Court against the Council's decisions. Appeals must reach the Court within 30 working days of receiving notice of the decision from the Council. A copy of any appeals must also be served on the Council.

Please note that any appeals must be received by 5pm Thursday 27 May 2021.
