This land is in the district of Weedons, not Rolleston.

The Selwyn Council and others are trying to blurr the lines between the 2 separate districts.

Weedons has its own identity, - its own school, brand new community centre, tennis courts, golf course, playground, to name a few.

Weedons has historical value having one of the oldest cricket clubs in the country.

Weedons has always been a separate district to Rolleston, even the address applied for in the plan change is identifying as 'Rolleston'. This is incorrect. This land is, and always has been Weedons.

The SDC has always said it doesn't want to 'wipe out' Weedons.

The creeping industrialization of the countryside is exactly what is happening here.

Reverse sensitivity issues cannot be managed. And there are houses directly opposite, and a school very close by.

The government is saying that land next to main townships must be looked at for housing. How can Weedons not be looked at for Rural Residential. ? There are so many blocks of land of 5 acres and above that could become say 1 acre lots in an instant.

Weedons as a district is perfectly positioned for easy access to the city with the new Southern Motorway on our doorstep, the new Temple Film Studio only minutes away, and Rolleston also only minutes away.

Being so close to the already thousands of acres of rezoned rural land, services could be easily provided by SDC.
