On reflection I have concluded that I should not attempt to identify particular matters that require comment. The matters which the applicant is likely to want to address are set out in the material

Regional Council and (to the extent relevant to the case for the

applicant) Ms Limmer, on behalf of Mr Shamy. Should any particular

of the hearing.
