queried whether there was scope or jurisdiction to consider the amendment.

5. Mr Cleary has provided submissions in relation to that issue. I do not consider that I need

further submissions on the scope issue. It is a matter that I will obviously carefully consider.

6. On a cautionary basis, and in case any of the parties have concerns in relation to scope for

that proposed change, I will delay the formal closing of the hearing to 5.00pm Monday 28

March 2022. If I do not receive submissions from any other party in relation to this issue, then

the hearing will close at that time.
