NCFF's submission point relating to EW-REQ3 referenced both offal pits and ancillary rural earthworks, however the s42 report only commented on the offal pit aspect of the submission. For completeness, the submission point should have also been referenced in section 22 of the 42A report, which covered 'rural ancillary earthworks' submissions. NCFF sought to remove the need for ancillary Rural Earthworks to meet be within the maximum cut depth outlined in EW-	 Paragraph 18.3, Page 31 Section 22, page 39 	DPR-0422.234 Federated Farmers of New Zealand - North Canterbury
REQ3.1. While section 22 did not reference this submission directly, it is my view that the views put forward in that section address this submission point in general, and the conclusion that Ancillary Rural Earthworks should not have special exemptions from meeting EW-REQ3.1. I recommend, for the reasons given above, that the Hearings Panel do not insert the ancillary rural earthworks provision requested, as outlined above.
