While the Canterbury Regional Council has the primary role in respect of discharges to the environment (to air and into waterbodies), the District Plan can assist by ensuring the adverse effects of any earthworks are minimised beyond the site where the works are occurring. Land use and discharge consents may also be required from the Canterbury Regional Council (Environment Canterbury) under either the Land & Water Regional Plan or the Canterbury Air Regional Plan. This Chapter does not apply to earthworks within the beds of lakes and rivers and the Coastal Marine Area, which are managed under the regional planning framework.¹
