	<p>Noise Management Plan</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The requiring authority shall prepare a Noise Management Plan (NMP), the primary objectives of which are to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <u>provide the community with assurance that the level of activity at the Range fits with the modelled contours and that the contours continue to be appropriate; and</u> <u>address the process for complaints and engagement with the community.</u> The NMP shall cover all firearms and detonation activities at the Range. The requiring authority shall provide the proposed NMP to Council's Group Manager Environmental and Regulatory Services (or equivalent position), no later than when it releases its decision pursuant to s172 RMA, for certification that the NMP meets the requirements of these conditions. 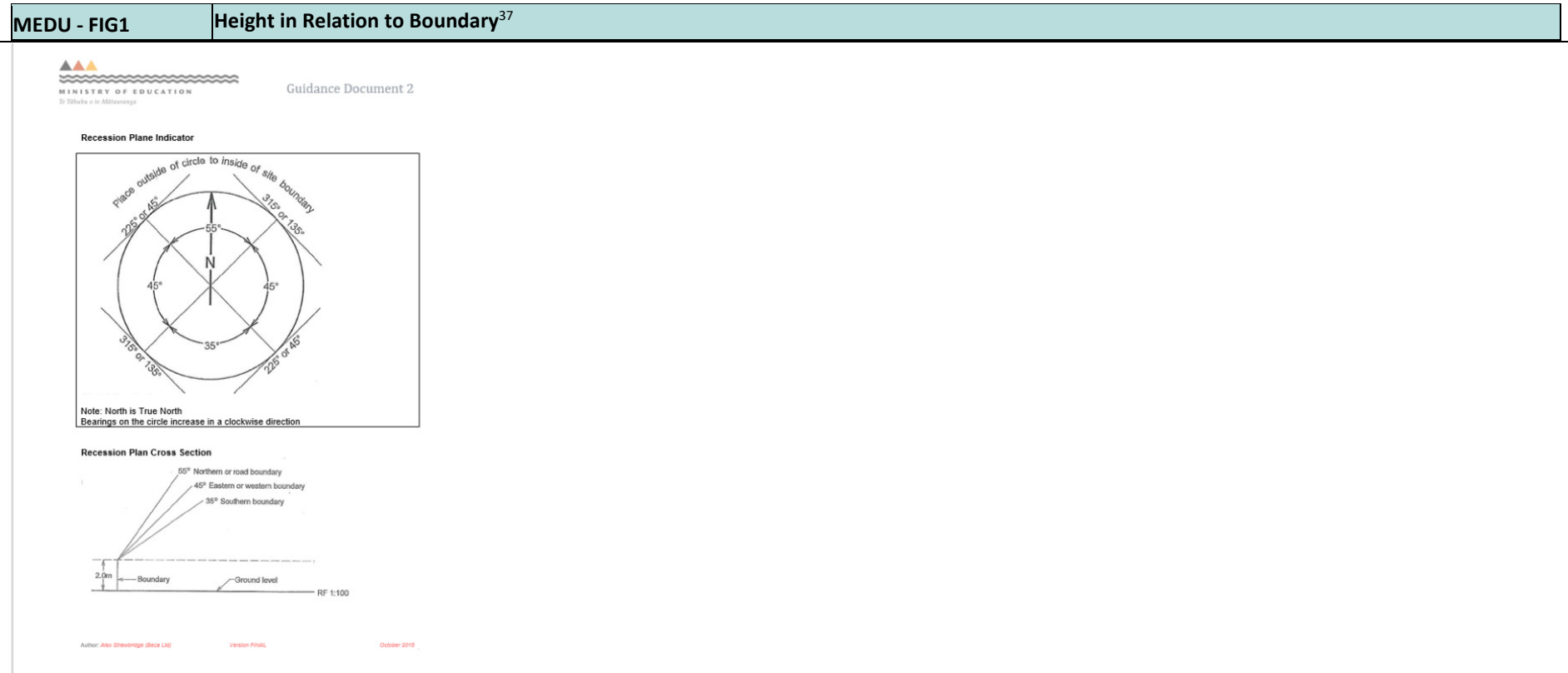
