Memorandum on behalf of the Director-General of Conservation *Tumuaki Ahurei* to the Chair of the Hearings Panel re Topic 1: Strategic Directions Hearing seeking short extension, dated 13 July 2021

## May it please the Chair of the Hearings Panel

- 1. The Director-General of Conservation *Tumuaki Ahurei* (Director-General) (submitter reference DPR-0427) is a submitter on the proposed District Plan (pDP).
- 2. The Hearings Panel issued a Notice of Hearing for Topic 1: Strategic Directions of the pDP. This notice sets key dates for providing expert evidence and legal submissions, with these being due on 23 July 2021 for expert evidence and 30 July 2021 for legal submissions.
- 3. The Director-General seeks to be heard (have speaking time) on his submission on the Strategic Directions Topic and wishes to call expert planning evidence and provide legal submissions to the Hearings Panel. I expect questions on the Director-General's evidence and legal submissions will take no more than 30 minutes.
- 4. I (Pene Williams) am counsel for the Director-General in this matter. I am taking scheduled leave from 16 23 July 2021 inclusive. On a separate matter where I am counsel, the Environment Court has directed legal submissions be filed in Court by 28 July 2021.<sup>1</sup>
