# Appendix 2: Recommended amendments

#### Part 1 – How the Plan Works – Relationship between Spatial Layers

#### **HPW-30 – Qualifying Matters**

Only those features that are classified as Qualifying Matters in accordance with clause 3.32 of the National Policy Statement on Urban Development (NPS-UD) and s77I and s77O of the Resource Management Act (Enabling Housing Supply and Other Matters) Act 2021 can be used to limit intensification, including within a Medium Density Residential Zones in Rolleston, Lincoln and Prebbleton townships. If a district-wide provision (e.g. relating to noise, signs or light) does not influence density and it is not identified as a Qualifying Matter, then it will continue to apply.

Qualifying Matter Areas including<sup>86</sup> within the a<sup>87</sup> relevant residential zones of Medium Density Residential Zones in Rolleston, Lincoln and Prebbleton townships comprise the following and are intended to limit intensification only to the extent necessary to accommodate the qualifying matter:<sup>89</sup>

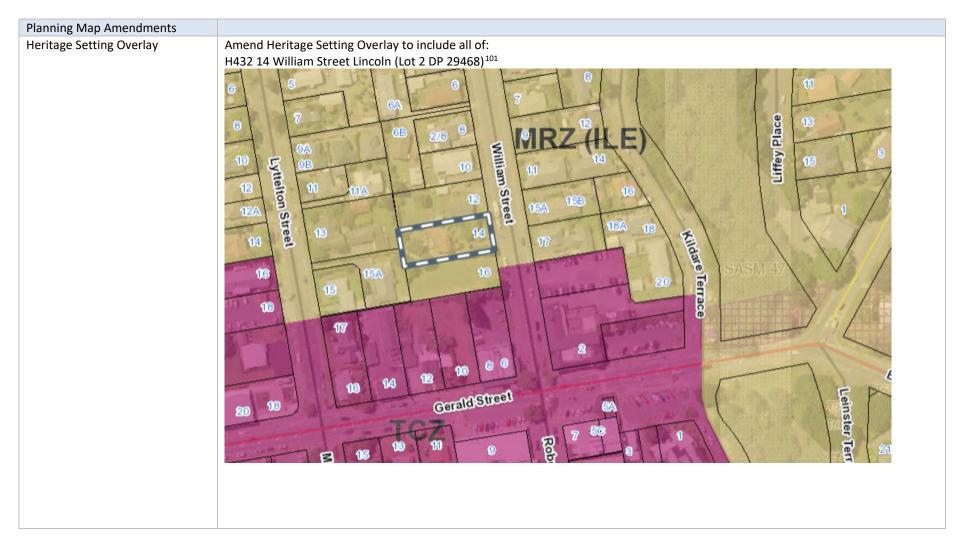

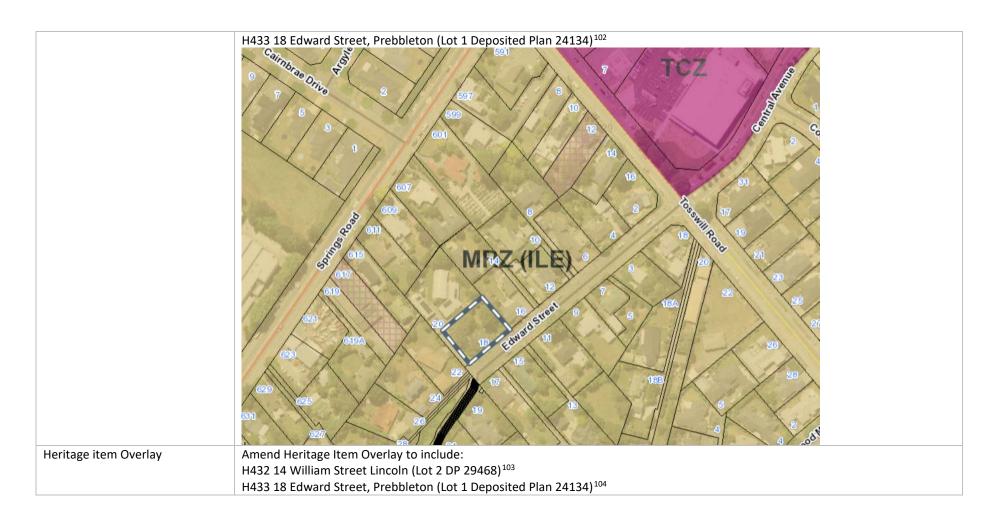
