Kia ora Charlotte,

My colleague Fraser was just discussing your email to him, and I was reminded I hadn't yet got to responding to this, apologies for the delay.

From our perspective we do not think that there are outstanding concerns requiring further engagement with manawhenua as we did consider the proposal holistically rather than only in relation to the CRC consents sought. However I do understand that in processing the consents required under the district plan, you need to ensure that the details relating to the wahi taonga site are clear in order to impose conditions.

I think the most pragmatic way to go about this would be for you to request further information from the applicant regarding the status of fencing and their proposed setback and use that in conjunction with our TWAS assessment to define appropriate conditions.

If you feel you need to engage our services for more specific input on the land use consent, we can prepare a quote. But I am not of the view that this would be of value to manawhenua or provide much substance beyond what has already been stated in the TWAS.

We feel it is appropriate that all of the recommendations we made via the TWAS influence your conditions or advice notes on the land use consent.

I hope this answers your questions, feel free to give me a call if you require further clarification.
