The reasons for our submission are:

- 1 Surface Flood Drain mitigation.
- 1 Pages 5 to 6 of the PDP (Pattle Delamore Partners) Stormwater Technical Assessment refer to heavy metal contaminants running off the site onto our property in a large scale storm event.

Page 6 of the document states "If future development is proposed at the southern neighbouring property

an infiltration drain can be installed along the 400m length of the southern boundary."

We are submitting that we are planning to develop our site with buildings, and have our own Resource Consent (RC 235064) from SDC for that. We therefore require the stormwater mitigation drain to be constructed, and we would like to be consulted on the ultimate disposal of the contaminated run-off water.

2 Flammability and seed dispersal of Akeake tree species in the landscape plan.

The Novo Group Visual Effects Assessment section 02.PLANTING PLAN has Akeake listed in the Plant List. A simple web search informs that this species is not suitable as it is on the Fire and Emergency New Zealand (FENZ) list of Moderate/High Flammability species. Our property also would be down-wind of the many light seeds that this species would disperse, so do not want the nuisance of this species.

We are very happy with the other suggested species, but please can we not plant Akeake.

The plan of the ROW on the Record of Title clearly shows the ROW as two (2) parts. Part C is linked to Lot 6 (now street number 80 - the solar farm site) and Part D is linked to
