this stage I am looking at undertaking the site visit on the morning of Thursday 11 August if

that is suitable to the occupier. If I need to be accompanied on the site, then the person accompanying me will need to be somebody who has not been a witness during the hearing.

I am reasonably flexible as to what times on the Thursday morning, from 9.00am onwards.

I will also be going through the surrounding environment to ensure I have a proper

understanding of the relationship of the site to the township and to the submitters. If any of
