

# Rakaia Huts Campground Rules

- Campers must register before they stay and pay the required fees.  
Check out time is 11am, unless by prior arrangement.
- Maximum stay is 50 days.  
After 50 days the site must be vacated for a minimum of 24 hours.
- Dogs are allowed but must be under control at all times.  
All dog owners must clean up after their pet and dogs are to be registered.
- Maximum speed within the campground is 15kph.
- Antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated.
- No excessive noise after 10pm and this will be strictly enforced.  
Christmas and New Years is an exception.
- Rubbish must be placed into the receptacles provided.
- Campsites are to be maintained in a clean and tidy condition at all times.
- Always park at least 1.5m from all site boundaries. Vans, Campers must be 3m apart.
- Kitchen and appliances must be left clean and tidy after use.  
No alcohol to be consumed in amenity building.
- No open fires are permitted, except in exceptional cases with prior approval.
- Quad bikes are permitted to be used within the campground by campers 16 years of age or older for the purposes of fishing or campground maintenance. All other motorbikes are prohibited. Selwyn District Council accepts no liability for their use.
- Generators are permitted between the hours of 9am–10pm, if they do not annoy other users.
- Campers are not permitted to mow their own sites.
- No digging of holes, removal or cutting of plants, shrubs or trees within the campground.
- No structures to be erected on sites.  
Windbreaks must be recognised as camping equipment.
- All vehicles to have current Warrant of Fitness/Registration and Electrical WOF if applicable.
- Dump station is for the exclusive use of campers only.
- Any damage to facilities must be reported to the caretaker.
- Failure to comply with the campground rules may result in a requirement to leave the property.
